



Volunteer Opportunities at Good Samaritan

Volunteer Opportunities: Most require a *weekly* commitment of 3 ½ hrs/week. Training will be provided, must be 18yrs. or older.

Clearinghouse:

Volunteers are needed to screen and refer clients to existing community resources or local churches. Through a network of more than 80 churches the Clearinghouse responds to over 4,000 emergency requests each year. Typical needs include transportation, financial needs and medical services.

Share Access-Job Coach:

This program helps persons seeking employment opportunities. Assist with resume writing, job searches and provide one on one mentoring as needed.

Receptionist:

Answer incoming phone calls and greet families coming into the office. Assist with mailings, filing, data entry and other administrative tasks as needed.

Rides Ministry:

Volunteers are needed to provide rides in the Holland/ Zeeland area, 1-2 times per week, to persons screened by us and in need of transportation to and from medical and social service appointments.

Affordable Housing Search Assistants:

Volunteers are needed to meet 1:1 with persons seeking affordable rental housing. The Affordable Housing Search Assistant will help determine eligibility for housing programs, help clients to determine their affordability limits, and use existing internet-based resources, etc., to identify prospective apartments. These volunteers also follow-up with clients following the initial meeting to offer ongoing assistance until stable housing is found.

Administrative – Graphic Design – Events:
