

FAQs



Q: Where will the run be held?

A: The run will take place on the beautiful Ridge Point Community Church Natural Area, a part of the Macatawa River Greenway System, 340 104th Ave., Holland, MI 49423

Q: What is the registration cost?

A: Registration before noon on June 7 is \$12 per Wild Runner, \$30 when registering 3 or more Wild Runners. Day of registration is \$15. Be sure to register at least 2 weeks before the race to be guaranteed a t-shirt. All runners will receive water, snack, and an awesome completion prize.

Q: What ages can participate?

A: Children ages 4-13, but there is plenty of fun to be had by all ages. BRING THE WHOLE FAMILY!

Q: What about my kids that are under 4 or over 13?

A: We will have activities for little ones at the head of the course! Kids over 14 are welcome to volunteer for the event, or run along with younger siblings as they maneuver the course!

Q: What time should we arrive?

A: Registration is from 9:00-10:45am. For those running the Short Course, you must be registered by 9:45am.

Q: What time does the run begin?

A: The Short Course will be run at 10:00am, the Long Course is run at 11:00am.

Q: What is the distance of the run?

A: The Short Course is a half mile. The Long Course is 2.5 miles.

Q: Can I drop my child off at the run and pick them up when it is finished?

A: No, a parent or guardian must be present at the event for their child to participate.

Q: Can adults run the course?

A: Yes! Parents are highly encouraged to join their children on the course. However adults are not allowed to maneuver obstacles as they are designed for children.

Q: Is the event timed?

A: No. Kids can move at their own pace through the course and obstacles. All obstacles are voluntary.

Q: What should we bring to the run?

A: Good running shoes, a towel, clothes that can get wet and dirty, and a sense of adventure!

Q: What if a child gets sick or injured?

A: A First Aid station will be onsite as well as a vehicle to quickly access all points of the course.

Q: How do we register?

Q: Will pictures be available from the event?

A: Pictures will be posted to the Good Samaritan Ministries Facebook page, so be sure to LIKE us on Facebook!

Q: What if the event is cancelled due to weather?

A: The event will be held in the rain and will only be cancelled if the weather is unsafe (lightening, tornados, snow storm—it is Michigan so weather is unpredictable). If the event is cancelled participants will be notified via the email address provided during registration. No refunds will be offered but participants will still be able to pick up their t-shirt.
